

# **SACRAMENTS & MINISTRY INFO**

### **ACTIVE PARISHIONER**

The criteria for an Active Parishioner are:

-Weekly participation in worship through attendance at Sunday Mass and on Holy Days of Obligation.

-Volunteer at St. Anthony's on regular basis (**Time**)
-Active involvement in a parish ministry/organization (**Talent**)
-Weekly or monthly use of parish envelopes or online giving (**Treasure**)

### PARISH REGISTRATION AND SACRAMENTS

Those seeking to receive the Sacraments of Baptism, First Holy Communion, Confirmation, and Matrimony **must be registered members** for <u>at least six months</u> prior to reception of these Sacraments. You must be a registered member of the parish to ask for Godparent or Sponsor's form of eligibility.

### **Infant Baptism Class for Parents**

Parents must be registered and active member of St. Anthony's. Class is offered on the third Thursday of every month. Pre-registration is required. Please call the office to pre-register. Baptisms are not celebrated during the Season of Lent.

### **First Holy Communion**

Preparation begins in the first grade and continues into second grade for a total of two years of preparation. Registration for Religious Education classes takes place in August. The first day of class is the third or fourth week in August.

### Confirmation

Preparation begins in the eighth grade and continues into ninth grade for a total of two years of preparation. Registration for Religious Education classes takes place in August. The first day of class is the third or fourth week of August. Adults who have not been confirmed and would like to receive the Sacrament are asked to contact the parish office.

### Marriage

You must be registered and active member at least six months prior to preparation of the Sacrament. Couples should call the parish office and speak to the priest/ Deacon for pre-nuptial inquiries. Then the couple will begin formal marriage preparations at least six months prior to the wedding date.

### Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA)

This is a process through which non-baptized adults known as catechumens or baptized adults who wish to convert from other faith traditions enter in communion with the Catholic Church. Classes begins in September. If you wish to become a Catholic, please call the parish office.

# FROM THE DESK OF OUR ADMINISTRATOR Fr. Emerson Rodriguez Delgado

Don't we live in a time of paradoxes, my friends? I mean, with technology, we're more "connected" than ever before, right? Yet many of us feel deeply isolated and alone. We're glued to our screens, endless scrolling, but true and authentic human connection seems to elude us.

But there's good news, my friends! The key to unlocking our loneliness is found in the open and loving arms of Jesus Christ. He is the ultimate master when it comes to forging connections that are deep, meaningful, and healing.

Just think about it: Jesus didn't just talk to lepers from a distance; He reached out and touched them. He broke down barriers of fear and stigma with a simple, compassionate touch. And we cannot forget St. Francis, who took it even further when he kissed a leper - now that's love and acceptance on a whole new level!

Jesus didn't just talk about inclusivity; He lived it. He shared meals with tax collectors, sinners, and the marginalized—those rejected by society. So, I ask you, are we willing to invite someone different to our dinner table?

And what about the Samaritan woman? Jesus chatted with her, a member of a group that Jews typically avoided and despised. He saw beyond the labels and recognized her true worth. How can we, here at St. Anthony's, embrace diversity and unity? Perhaps it starts with sharing more than just a pew.

In the Gospel of Mark, Jesus heals a deaf and mute man with a single and powerful word: "Ephphatha," which means "Be opened." That's an invitation for all of us. When we interact with others, are we truly listening with the intent to understand, or are we just waiting to make our point? Do our words build up our sense of community or do they tear it down like a wrecking ball?

"Ephphatha" invites us to open our hearts and minds, to embrace kindness and encouragement, and to live out the joyful spirit of Afro-American spirituality.

When we open ourselves to Christ's healing touch, we step into a new world of connection—with God, with others, with ourselves, and even with nature. So, here's food for thought, how can we live as "opened" people on a daily basis?

Authentic connection happens when we dare to be vulnerable and transparent. When someone hurts you, remember how much Christ has forgiven you. Extend that same radical grace, and witness how it heals relationships and breathes new life into them. Is there someone you've been meaning to call or reconnect with? Don't wait another second, my friend.

In a world yearning for authentic connection, we can be the change agents, reflecting Christ's loving touch and breaking down walls of isolation and division. We can do this, church!

Let us pray for Jesus to open our hearts, helping us see others through his lens of love, acceptance, and compassion.

In Christ, we are reborn as new creations, designed for connection that reaches into eternity. Let's embrace it with everything we've got! Again, "Ephphatha"!
