No prior knowledge or theology is required, just an open heart ready to assist people in encountering Jesus and be touched by the Holy Spirit. Volunteers will help with planning, attending weekly meetings as greeters, hosts, meal facilitators, and prayer warriors.

What is Alpha and Who is it for?

Alpha is a 10-week progressive series of meetings and videos (plus a one day retreat) that explores the basics of the Christian faith. Each session looks at a different question around faith, and the talks are designed to create conversation in small groups. It's non-denominational, totally free, and run all over the globe. Regardless of background or beliefs, EVERYONE is welcome! It's been running and growing successfully at St. Mary Madgalene for 10 years. It is an easy way to refresh your faith or bring someone in who is uncommitted in their faith to learn about Jesus.

All sessions start with a meal and time to connect and build friendships. The content starts with videos which explore the big questions we all ask, and unpack the basics of Christian faith. Important Notice: Temporary Church Closure & Pew Installation (July 6th - 24th)

We are thrilled to announce that the long-awaited installation of our new church pews and flooring is officially scheduled! To allow the crew to work safely and efficiently, the main church sanctuary will be closed from Monday, July 6th through Friday, July 24th.

While our worship space undergoes this beautiful transformation, our sacramental life continues! Please note the temporary location changes, schedule adjustments, and parking updates below:

Temporary Locations & Schedule Changes

- **Daily Masses:** Temporarily held in the **School Chapel**.
- **Weekend Masses:** Temporarily held in the **School Gymnasium**.
- **Saturday Confessions:** Held in the **School Chapel** (or call the Parish Office to schedule an appointment).
- **⚠️ Wednesday Cancellations:** There will be **NO 4:00-6:00 PM Adoration/Confessions and NO 6:00 PM Mass on Wednesdays** during this three-week closure period.

Parking & Logistics for Weekend Masses (School Gymnasium)

Please plan ahead for attending Mass in the School Gymnasium during the installation period:

- **Handicap Parking:** The Gallivan Center (Parish Office) parking lot will be strictly reserved for handicap parking only.
- **Drop-Offs:** You may swing by the parish parking lot to drop off passengers at the back entrance of the School Gymnasium before parking in the main Church Parking Lot. You can then reach the gym via the steps or the elevator.
- **Elevator Wait Times:** Please keep in mind that the elevator has an occupancy and weight limit, which may result in long wait times.
- **Arrive Early:** Because of these logistical changes, we highly suggest giving yourself ample time to arrive for Mass.

We anticipate returning to our beautifully refreshed sanctuary the weekend of July 25th-26th. Thank you so much for your patience, flexibility, and cooperation as we improve our spiritual home for generations to come!

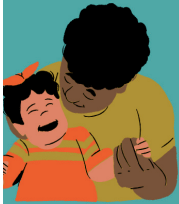

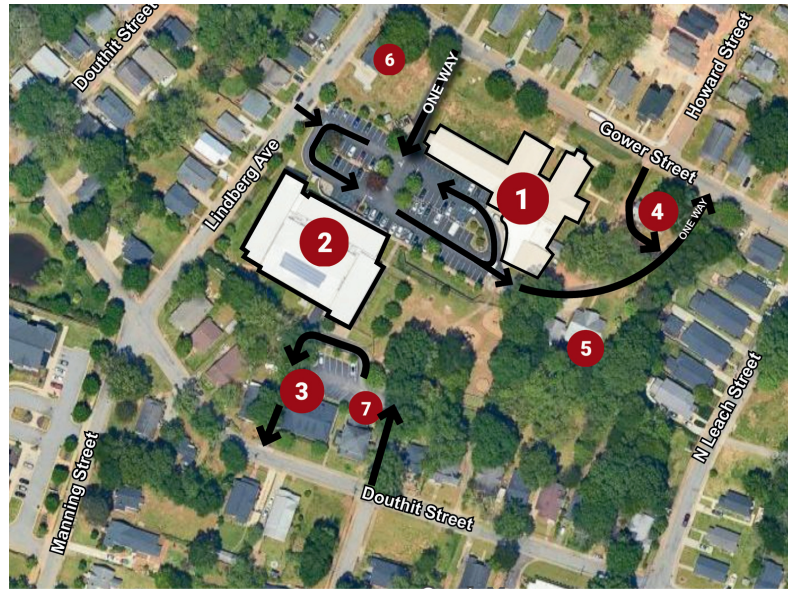
